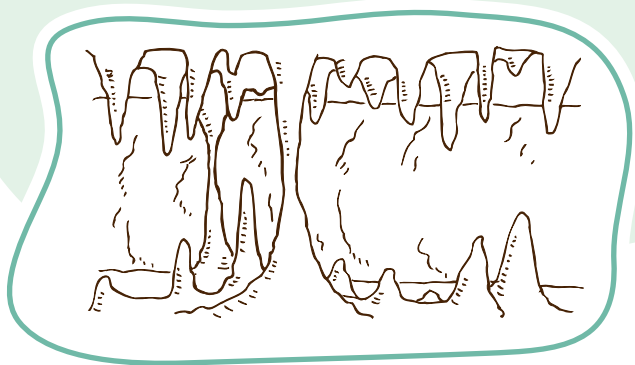
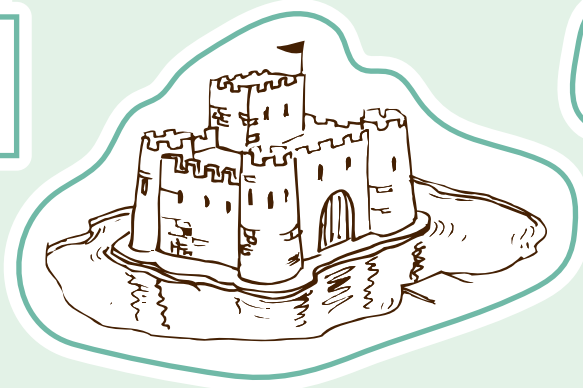
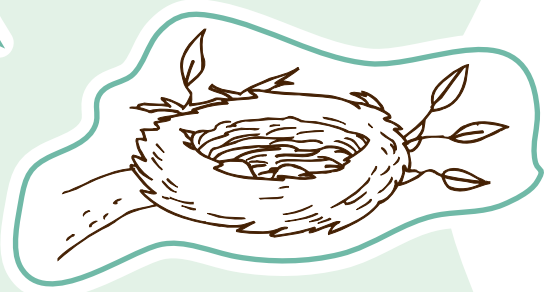
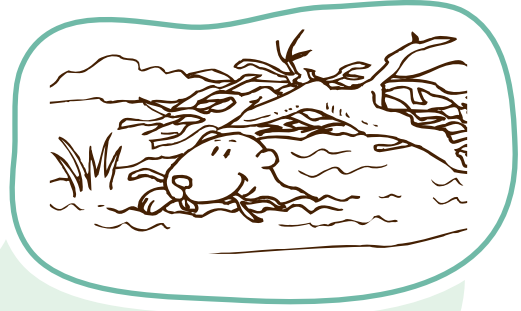
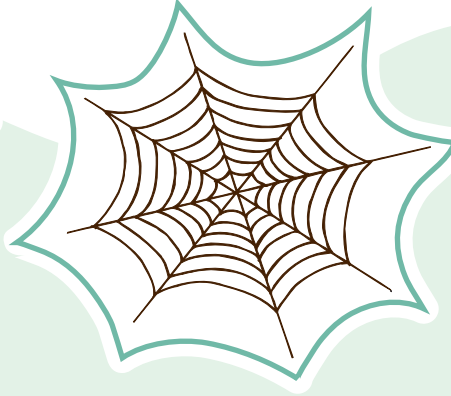
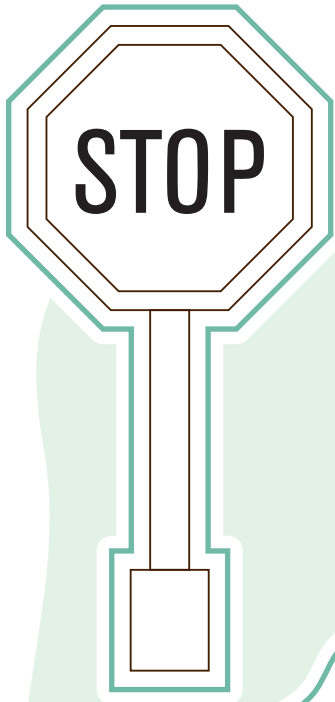


Do you know this amazing structure? This is The Great Wall of China, which is the longest structure ever built.
