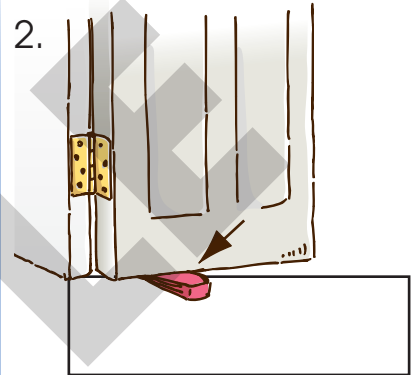
A. Each picture shows a type of simple machine. Name the simple machines and circle the correct words to complete the descriptions.

wheel and axle pulley screw lever wedge inclined plane



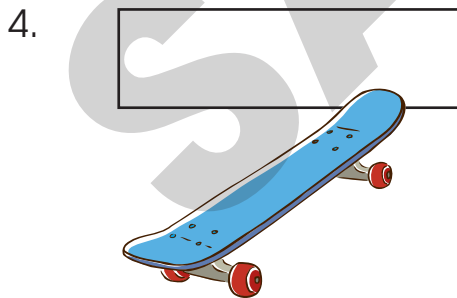
a **wheel / rod** and a rope working together to move a load



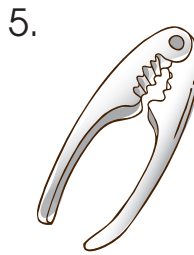
a slanting side ending in a sharp edge that **pushes / pulls** things apart
