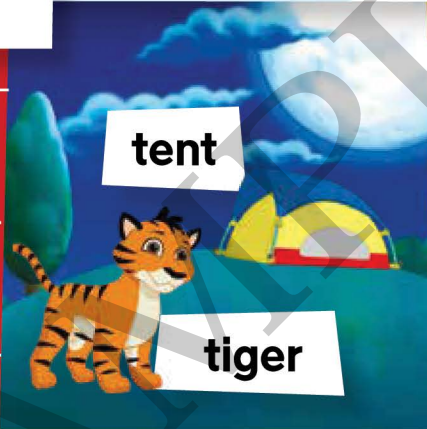

T is for **t**iger, approaching a **t**ent. He's sniffing the night air. What is that scent?

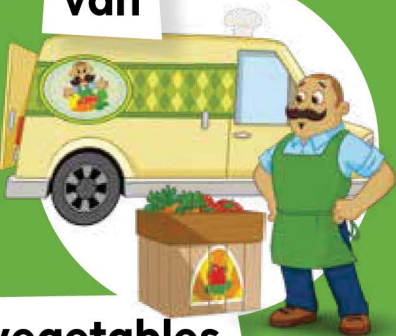
U is for **u**niform, worn by a pup, riding a **u**nicycle and, standing straight up.
